

# RITTS Tutorial: MAKING AND SAVING A GERIATRIC ORTOPEDIC REFERRAL

After logging in as *support staff*, your homepage will look like this. To make a geriatric orthopedic referral, click on the *Make An Inpatient Geriatric Orthopaedic referral to SCOHS – Elizabeth Bruyere* link.

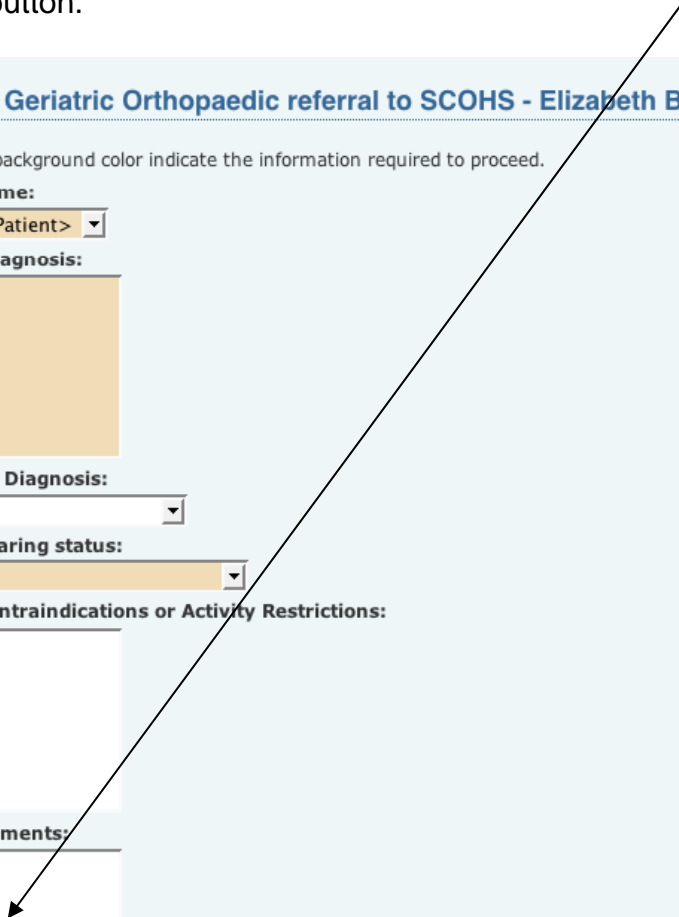
